#### What is the Statewide Campus System?

- The Statewide Campus System (SCS) is a Graduate Medical Education (GME) consortium that is part of Michigan State University's College of Osteopathic Medicine (MSUCOM).
- Serve more than 28 hospital and FQHC sites across Michigan.
- Annually, provide GME and CME education and training to over 2,000 residents/fellows and about 1,500 faculty.
